## Range of wellbeing concerns and pathways

Concerns that do not indicate immediate risk to safety and security of te tamaiti

No indication of serious harm

Concerns about risks to longer-term wellbeing. Require response from relevant agencies.

Advice and assistance

Partnered response

Advocate with other agencies if need for immediate action

Concern about the immediate impact on wellbeing of te tamaiti - as a consequence of unmet needs for example, stability of housing, urgent health needs

Risk of serious harm related to abuse or neglect is not indicated

Serious harm has been indicated, but protective factors are or may be present now that manage the risks

Advocate with other agencies if need for immediate action

Partnered response

Consider if complexity suggests that assessment is desirable

Concerns that child or young person is being harmed, or at risk of serious harm

Assessment (or investigation) is necessary and desirable

Consider need for immediate action (safety and risk screen)

Note – after assessment and safety planning, may subsequently decide that serious harm is not indicated.
